





An above ground or semi-mounded tank needs sufficient space. The tank must be 3m clear of any source of ignition, 1.5m from overhead cables and the area it's in must be free of rubbish and combustible materials.

If you would prefer not to spread your payments over 12 months, you can also opt to pay for each delivery in full by Direct Debit. This will be set up when you join Calor.




